Nebraska Walk for Life

There's something NEW with the annual Nebraska Walk for Life! In celebration of the reversal of Roe v Wade, the *inaugural Walk for Life Gala*, a fundraiser for Nebraska Right to Life, will be held the night before the Walk. This year's featured speaker, Dr. John Bruchalski, will be participating in both events, and will describe his journey from a physician performing abortions to a leading light in pro-life medicine.
