In celebration of the reversal of Roe v Wade, the *inaugural Walk for Life Gala*, a fundraiser for Nebraska Right to Life, will be held the night before the Walk. 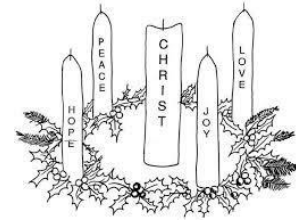
