## Nebraska Walk for Life

There's something NEW with the annual Nebraska Walk for Life! In celebration of the reversal of Roe v Wade, the *inaugural Walk for Life Gala*, a fundraiser for Nebraska Right to Life, will be held the night before the Walk. Come join your fellow pro-lifers for either or both. This year's featured speaker, Dr. John Bruchalski, will be participating in both events, and will describe his journey from a physician performing abortions to a leading light in pro-life medicine.
