My brother-in-law and his unit are stationed in South Korea and in charge of securing the base during its lockdown due to Coronavirus. In visiting with my sister, there morale is very low. This is an extremely tough time for them. They are only getting two hours of a sleep a night and don’t have time to get any supplies. I have placed a tote in the vestibule for anyone that would like to donate to this group of soldiers. I will cover all shipping charges. If anyone is interested, please place the items in the bag and sign the card next to the tote. Suggested items: Bar soap, deodorant, beef jerky, gum, snacks (crackers/cookies), toothpaste, Candy (not chocolate bars...M&M’s, Mike & Ikes, etc.), anything else you can think of that would travel well. It takes about 7 days to get there.
