### **HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION All Saints Day – Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>**

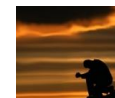

**ALL SOUL'S DAY** - On All Souls Day, we not only remember the dead, but we apply our efforts, through prayer, almsgiving, and the Mass, to their release from Purgatory. There are two plenary indulgences (remission of the **entire** temporal punishment due to sin) attached to All Souls Day, one for visiting a church and another for visiting a cemetery. (The plenary indulgence for visiting a cemetery can also be obtained every day from November 1-8, and, as a partial indulgence, on any day of the year.) While the actions are performed by the living, the merits of the indulgences are applicable only to the souls in Purgatory. In order to obtain a plenary indulgence, the following conditions must be met within 7 days before or after the work performed: 1. Sacramental Confession 2. Holy Communion and 3. Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

If you would like your loved ones remembered on All Soul's Day, please place their names on the All Soul's Day envelope mailed in your packet or on one of the envelopes in the back of church and turn in **before All Soul's Day**. If you would like separate Masses said for those listed on your envelope, you may include Mass stipends in that envelope. The regular Mass stipend in our Diocese is \$10.
