

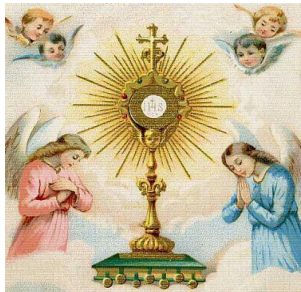

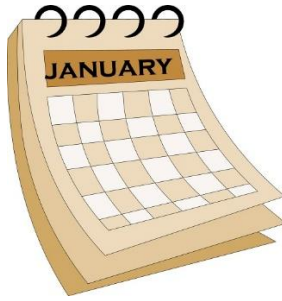

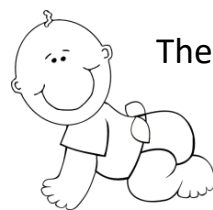


Please pray for the seminarians and the sick parishioners of St. Ann and Sacred Heart.
