## LEARNING MOMENT

**Remembering the Poor Souls in November** A plenary indulgence for visiting a cemetery can be obtained every day from November 1-8, and, as a partial indulgence, on any day of the year. While the actions are performed by the living, the merits of the indulgences are applicable only to the souls in Purgatory. In order to obtain a plenary indulgence, the following conditions must be met within 7 days before or after the work performed: 1. Sacramental Confession 2. Holy Communion and 3. Prayer for the intention of the Holy Father.

**A plenary indulgence** is the remission of the entire temporal punishment due to sin so that no further expiation is required in Purgatory.

**ALL SOUL’S DAY - Praying for the dead** is a Christian obligation. The Church devotes November to [prayer for the Holy Souls in Purgatory](#). If you would like a Mass said for your loved ones please place their names on the All Soul’s Day envelope mailed in your packet or on one of the envelopes in the back of church and place in the collection basket. The usual Mass stipend in our Diocese is \$10; however, Fr. Faulkner will gladly offer Mass without a stipend.
