# LEARNING MOMENT

Masses offered for still-living persons (including yourself) are more beneficial than Masses offered for deceased persons. Masses for the dead will provide for them a God-assigned "*indulgence*" (a curtailing of the duration and / or intensity of purgatorial suffering). But if Mass is offered as intercession for persons while still alive and in the state of grace—i.e., no *unrepented* serious sin (1 John 5:16), these living persons receive three added benefits not available to the dead, namely:

1) Increase of merit (assigned heavenly joy and glory **forever**—*CCC* 2010).

2) Added sanctifying grace (a deeper sharing in the life of God—2 Pet. 1:4).

3) *Actual graces* (conscience-nudges to do good and avoid evil— *CCC 2000*),

Hence, while a Mass offered for a deceased person can provide great relief, a Mass offered for a living person can provide great growth.
