Nebraska Walk for Life

There's something NEW with the annual Nebraska Walk for Life! In celebration of the reversal of Roe v Wade, the *inaugural Walk for Life Gala*, a fundraiser for Nebraska Right to Life, will be held the night before the Walk. Come join your fellow pro-lifers for either or both. This year's featured speaker, Dr. John Bruchalski, will be participating in both events, and will describe his journey from a physician performing abortions to a leading light in pro-life medicine. Tickets for the Gala, which will be at Embassy Suites in Lincoln on Friday, January 27, 2023, are \$50, and can be purchased online at nebraskarighttolife.ticketspice.com/2023, or send a check made out to Nebraska Right to Life (noting it is for Gala), PO Box 80410, Lincoln, NE 68501-0410. The Nebraska Walk for Life on January 28 begins at the State Capitol at 10:00 a.m. followed by the walk to the UNL Student Union and Dr. Bruchalski's keynote speech at 11:30.

January 22 is the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children". In all the Dioceses of the United States, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday), shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.
