Jubilee Year 2025: Pilgrims of Hope



What is a Juliee Year? A Jubilee Year is traditionally proclaimed by the Universal Church every 25 years. It is a particular year set aside to encourage the faithful to embark on pilgrimages, to repent of their sins and forgive the sins of others, and to renew a focus on the spiritual life.

Notes from Bishop Conley on the Jubilee Year

A way to obtain a Jubilee Indulgence is to visit one of the eight sites in our diocese I have designated as Jubilee pilgrimage sites. These sites are: The Cathedral of the Risen Christ, Lincoln; The Pink Sisters Chapel, Lincoln; St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, North Platte; St. Benedict, Nebraska City; St. Mary, Orleans; St. Anthony, Steinauer; Assumption, Dwight; Our Lady of Fatima Shrine, Arapahoe

In addition to pilgrimages to these local sanctuaries, or to national or international designated holy sites, one can also obtain an indulgence through works of mercy and acts of penance. This is a year to strive to rediscover the Sacraments, imitate the mercy of the Father by feeding the hungry, visiting the sick and comforting the sorrowful, and spend time in prayer and reflection.

CROSS OF CONTINUED GIVING @ St. Ann's

Many of you may have noticed the Cross plaque hanging next to the Sacristy. However, you may not be aware of the significance of the plaque. Father Kurz started the Cross of Continued Giving while he was here. The Cross plaque has to do with that. So, what is the Cross of Continued Giving? If you would like to give a

donation in memory of your loved one that has passed (minimum of \$500), that money will go into the Cross of Continued Giving fund, and your loved one's name will go on the plaque. The fund must maintain a minimum balance of \$5,000. Anything above the \$5,000 can be requested to be used for a project towards repairing or improving something that has to do with the Church building. Funds can only be accessed once per year.
